How is COVID Affecting Your Districts?

- Washoe: Had to furlough most employees for a month. With meal counts rising again they were able to hire everyone back on and are now hiring new people. They are having a hard time finding subs. Current plans are to open 'normally' next year with all students in seat 5-days a week.
- Carson: Meals are going up as kids return to seat. Currently PK-8th grade are in seat Tuesday-Friday and 9-12th is still hybrid. Monday remains a remote day for all students. They are also having a hard time finding subs.
- Douglas: Elementary has been in school all year and last month middle and high school came back so currently all students are in seat 5-days a week. Meals are up because everyone is in seat and eating for free. Because of the rapid pace in bringing all students back there have been some supply issues but they are finding what they need through alternative sources (commercial vs. commodity, etc.)
- China Springs: Meal counts are going up. Budget is uncertain for next year.
